## Camp is

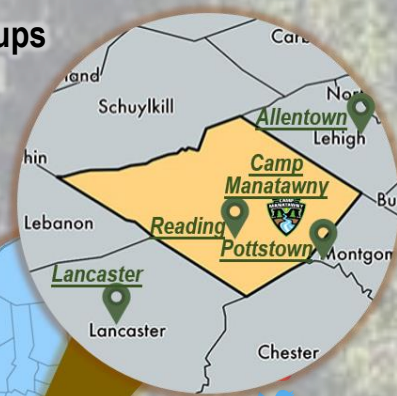

**Deposit & Payment:** A \$50 non-refundable deposit must be paid at time of registration in order to reserve a place in the desired overnight session. Final payment must be made before arriving for the start of the overnight session.
